# School Uniform

Please remember, we want our children to wear their school badge with pride and for people to look at our pupils and their first impression be 'WOW! These children really represent Towcester Primary School well!

Please could we ask that all children wear the expected uniform to school unless an agreement with the school has been reached for special circumstances. Please avoid sending your child to school in trainers or 'astros'.

School uniform expectations are as follows:

- black or grey trousers or skirt,
- a plain white polo-shirt or shirt, with school logo where possible
- a blue school jumper or cardigan with the school logo
- black or grey socks or tights
- smart, closed-toe black leather shoes. No trainers or astros please.

During warmer months:

- blue and white summer dresses.
- smart black or grey shorts

Hair:

- We ask that long hair is kept neatly tied back during school time.
- Simple headbands may be worn in the school colours.
- Please do not send your child into school wearing large bows, clips, scrunchies or headbands.

Please ensure that all clothing is clearly labelled with a sewn-in label or a Sharpie (Biro washes out) as we already have a mountain of unclaimed clothing, most of it unnamed.

We are aware how quickly the children grow and how uniform can be costly. To support with this, we will set up a clothes rail of good condition pre-loved uniform that can be bought (£1 per item) from the main reception area.

If anyone has any donations of pre-loved uniform (sweatshirts, cardigans, trousers, skirts, badged white T shirts) that is in good condition to add to our supply, please do bring it in to the main reception.

#### Attendance

If your child is too unwell to attend school, please could we ask that you contact us before 9:00am so that we can mark them absent on the register. If we do not hear from you, the following process will be followed:

- Parents/carers will be called to discuss the reason for the absence.
- If school staff are unable to make contact, a home visit will be made on day 2 of the absence period. A red card alert will be left/posted at the home address asking you to contact school as a matter of urgency. If there is no answer at home address the school will attempt to contact any additional contacts held by the school.
- The family and contacts will be telephoned daily until contact is made.

# SATS Periods

As May approaches, we enter the SATs windows for our Year 6 and Year 2 pupils. Please do try to ensure that your child is in school for their tests, this is particularly important for our Year 6 pupils whose tests are scheduled for specific days.

Year 4 children will have their Multiplication Tables Checks in the two week window commencing Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June. Our Year 1 pupils will sit their Phonics Screening Checks in the week commencing Monday 12<sup>th</sup> June. Please support us by ensuring that your child is in school during these periods.
