
We have had a busy term with so much to celebrate!

Term-time holidays

We have noticed an increase in the number of applications for absences to take holidays in term time. We will be unable to authorise any applications for absence due to holiday and will refer families to the Local Authority for Penalty Notices in these instances.

Your child's attendance at school ensures that they build good learning habits, gain the carefully sequenced knowledge that is planned and maintain consistent friendships. Please avoid boking holidays in term time, the school holidays provide ample time for this.

School Day Timings

The school gates open at 8.40 both at the Islington Road and the Rec entrances, children should walk straight to their lines ready for their teachers to take them into school at 8.50am. Our school day starts at 8.50am and therefore, children arriving after that time will need to go to the main school entrance. The gates will be closed to admitting children to the site at 8.50am promptly.

We've all experienced that feeling of arriving late somewhere; we know that arriving late to school can cause your child to be anxious and flustered and to miss important learning at the very start of the day.

We understand that on occasions things happen that make us late but ask that, if you are frequently late to school, you review your morning routine and timings or ask for some help from our Family Support Worker Mrs McShane, she is always glad to help.
