



# Year 1 – Summer 1 – KIRFS – Adding doubles

Key Instant Recall Facts (KIRFs) are designed to support the development of the mental skills that underpin much of the maths work in school. Instant recall facts help enormously with mental agility within maths lessons.

Your child's KIRFS this term are to add doubles. Children will benefit immensely from knowing these instant recall facts.

$1 + 1 = 2$

$2 + 2 = 4$

$3 + 3 = 6$

$4 + 4 = 8$

$5 + 5 = 10$

$6 + 6 = 12$

$7 + 7 = 14$

$8 + 8 = 16$

$9 + 9 = 18$

$10 + 10 = 20$

$11 + 11 = 22$

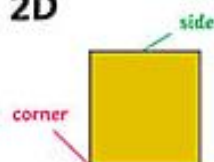
$12 + 12 = 24$

Please practice these often. They are very important and will be built on as they move into Year 2.

- Finding 1 more and one less than a given number to 100.
- Counting in 2's, 5's and 10's
- Practice simple addition and subtraction questions within 20.

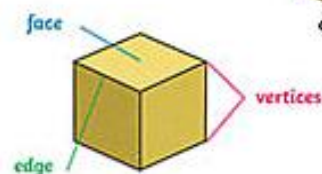
