### **2018/19 Key Stage Two Assessment Results**

At the end of Key Stage Two in Year 6 pupils are assessed using nationally designed tests (SATs).

The tests are scored and pupils are given a 'scaled score' which compares their performance to an expected standard of 100 and a higher standard of 110.

## Progress from Key Stage 1 to Key Stage 2 in Reading, Writing and Maths

The Progress Measure compares our pupils' progress with other pupils nationally who had a similar level of attainment at Key Stage One. The difference is calculated to establish whether our pupils are making the same amount of progress as other pupils nationally.

- **A score of 0** means that pupils in this school **do as well** as other pupils nationally (average).
- **A positive score** means that pupils in this school on average do **better** than other pupils nationally (average)
- **A negative score** means that pupils in this school **do not do as well** as other pupils nationally (average)
