Key Texts: The Secret Sky Garden and Vlad and the Great fire of London

Purpose for writing: Setting description

The focus for the children's writing this term is to create a setting description. They will be taught new vocabulary which they can use in their writing. They will also learn new skills such writing expanded noun phrases and using 'because' correctly.

History

The Great Fire of London
A significant event in History

Our focus this term will be exploring the content of London in 1666 and the conditions that assisted the spread of the fire.
