Year 3 - What do Christians learn from the Creation Story?



What we already know:

Foundation Stage – F1 Why is the word 'God' so important to Christians? For Christians the word God is very important. He is the creator of the universe and all that is in it. A church is a Christian place of worship. Christians pray and sing to God. Christians are taught to respect God's name and use it with love and care because God is holy and great. Year 1/2 – 1:2 Who made the world?

What's next?

Year 5 - U2.2 Creation & Science — Conflicting or Complimentary? Outline the importance of Creation on the timeline of the 'big story' of the Bible. Suggest what Genesis 1 might mean and compare their ideas with ways in which Christians interpret it. Make connections between Genesis 1 and Christian belief about God as Creator. Understand why many Christians find science and faith go together. Weigh up how far the Genesis 1 creation narrative is in conflict, or is complementary, with a scientific account.

Summary of Knowledge

God the Creator cares for the creation, including human beings. As human beings are part of God's good creation, they do best when they listen to God. The Bible shows that God wants to help people to be close to him — he keeps his relationship with them, gives them guidelines on good ways to live (such as the Ten Commandments), and offers forgiveness even when they keep on falling short. Christians show that they want to be close to God too, through obedience and worship, which includes saying sorry. Christians believe God made our wonderful world and so we should look after it. The Bible tells a story (in Genesis 3) about how humans spoiled their friendship with God (sometimes called 'the Fall').
